TAPE ART BY ATAU

I am an artist working with tape, based in Berlin. My art works, installations and murals can be found in galleries, exhibitions, street art events and festivals around the world.

To develop new room experiences through tape and interact with the given space is what fascinates me. I create unique artistic concepts in order to reshape interior and exterior spaces.

Recently my work was exhibited in Tokyo at the 3331 art gallery as part of the Mt-art project by Mt masking tape Japan.

In my artistic approach I experiment with the medium tape and question its basic principles: through cuts and omissions, I dissolve straight lines, integrate circular shapes, leave gaps through which the materiality of the surface becomes visible as a further level. Color overlaps and offsets create gradients that, depending on the position of the spectator, decompose the lines when viewed.

My point of departure are often structures and grids into which I zoom in and out with great detail: urban networks, image elements such as pixels, nervous systems connecting with each other. I often work intuitively and without a template.

NATURAL BORN DIGITAL

What fascinates you about creating spatial art?
Boundaries and crossing them is something that has always interested me.

For me, art that is bounded by a frame is like a window that allows a limited glimpse into another world. The artist decides what he/ she wants to show. Anything beyond that is not visible to the viewer. What fascinates me is to climb through this window and think of the artwork in a 3-dimensional way.

When I create a room installation, I have the opportunity to create a work of art that the viewer can enter. The artwork changes depending on the position of the viewer. It can be explored and discovered. Every room I design is unique. I love playing with spaces, reacting to them or consciously working against them.












JUNG VON MATT ACADEMY

It's difficult to estimate the amount of time that went into designing the JvM Academy. Cord and I worked about 700 hours on the project. About 7000 meters of tape were used in the installation. This project demanded everything from me in every respect. Several nights we worked through. Special material that we imported from Japan. New techniques and materials that I learned to use and love. All these factors make the Academy a unique work of art for me. A work of art that not only features bright colors, but is also meant to be lived with and used.








HERZBLUT INSTALLATION


Inspired by art from the hippie movement and artists like Heinz Edelmann, the illustrator of the Beatle film Yellow Submarine, I created a digital artwork (4096 x 1714px) to develop a unique style for this project. The installation consists of a main motif which is connected to another motif on the opposite wall via a wide strip that runs across the ceiling. I was fascinated by the idea of creating 4 artworks which thematically take up the forms and color language of the installation. The Herzblut series is presented in the left corner of the room. From the first draft and during the artistic process the artwork expanded into an installation.











HERE COMES THE SUN

Schule am Weinweg is a school in Karlsruhe, Germany with a special focus on students with visual impairments. The challenge for this project was therefore to create a room installation that would be interesting and exciting for people with and without visual impairments. To transform the space into a work of art, I decided to integrate the entire ceiling into the artwork. This almost makes it look like the ceiling no longer exists, and instead you look through the open space at an abstract sky. From my window on the 6th floor, you can look out over the rooftops of Berlin. The vibrant colors of the sunlight shining through the evening clouds are a great source of inspiration for me.






EXHIBITION TOKYO

In 2020, together with the Berlin-based artist collective Tape That, I designed a room at 3331 Arts Chiyoda in Tokyo.

There we were part of an international exhibition featuring tape artists from all over the world. Together with Infra and Adrian Dittert we created the sculpture DASMO. The sculpture consists of wooden panels that have been precisely inserted into each other.

Japanese culture and the local Washi tape had a big influence on my style at that time. I started to apply the tape in strips, cut them apart and put them together in a distorted way.










"Upstream" explores the profound question: Are humans doomed to fail?


Streams are formed when many small flows begin to merge together and swell into one large stream. These currents consist of countless particles that compete with and influence each other, creating a vacuum that forces the entire flow in one direction. The stream continues to move. During this process, it absorbs particles and becomes increasingly powerful. The ever growing stream floods the system from which it feeds, inevitably unbalancing it, threatening to destroy itself.

The idea of a stream consisting of individual particles inspired Atau to create the installation "Upstream" in collaboration with 4 other artists. The aim was to influence each other throughout this process: creating in ways where the individual structures can complement, strengthen or weaken each other. Reinforcing the intentionally unpredictable result by the collective work.


From an artistic standpoint, this perspective is probably unorthodox, but I personally find it exciting to deal with and solve problems.




